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# THE WAY TO ROMAVERSITAS

## EDUCATIONAL BACKGROUND

After the transition in the new republic in Hungary:

### **Educational expansion:**

- secondary education  
40% to 80%
- entering higher education  
10% to 50%

### **Roma population:**

- **secondary school 20%,**
- **5% graduates**
- **1-2% enters higher education**



Without Roma **graduates, professionals,**  
and **leaders** in Hungary,  
the deep-rooted problems of  
**poverty** and **unemployment, isolation** and  
**prejudice** continues to grow worse.

# PRINCIPLES OF ROMAVERSITAS FOUNDATION

Direct financial support is **not sufficient**

Financial **support conditioned to participation** in special training programs - contract with each student

Romaversitas operates through a **set of integrated, long-term professional programs**

Program based on **academic competition**

# BENEFICIARIES

- Full-time Roma university students
- From the second year of university studies
- The most highly talented and highly motivated students are selected
- 50 Romaversitas scholars in 2008/09
- Underprivileged backgrounds, substandard education



# KEYSTONES OF THE PROGRAM

for promising young Roma students through:

# MONTHLY GRANT

Many Roma students cannot afford the expenses of university; they cannot rely on family support.

Romaversitas provides **monthly scholarship fee** to help the students pay housing, books and other personal necessities.

Beneficiaries of the program are enabled to **fully concentrate on their area of study.**



# SKILLS TRAINING

Disadvantage entering university  
due to substandard schooling:

Language, IT training and  
communication skills development

Students are offered professional  
opportunities such as  
basic and academic tutoring  
seminars on various topics



# COMMUNITY BUILDING

Discuss challenges and learn from Roma professionals on how to succeed at school and in their careers

*orientation*

*social problems*



# ACHIEVEMENTS

During the past ten years **198 students** attended the program.

**95% graduated successfully** from a higher educational institute.

**20%** of the graduates is working in **programs aiming at developing the Hungarian Roma situation.**

**10%** of the graduates are **PhD students** at the moment.
