Welcome to the Listening component of the Matura Examination.

The exam consists of three tasks. The listening material and the instructions are recorded on this cassette, and the tasks and the instructions are printed in this test booklet.

- Every task will begin with some music, and then you will hear (and you can also read) the instructions to the task.
- This will be followed by a silent period on the cassette in order to give you some time to study the task in your test booklet before hearing the text.
